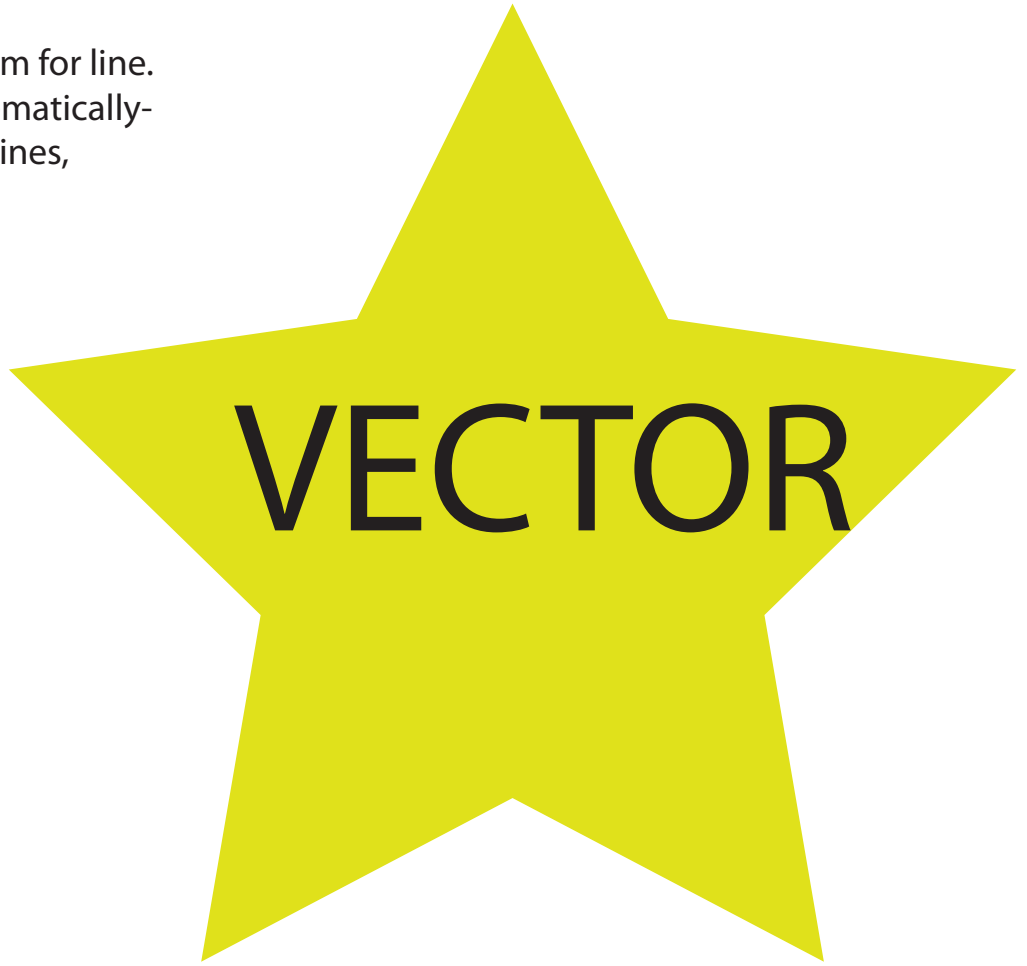
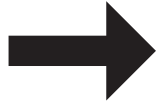


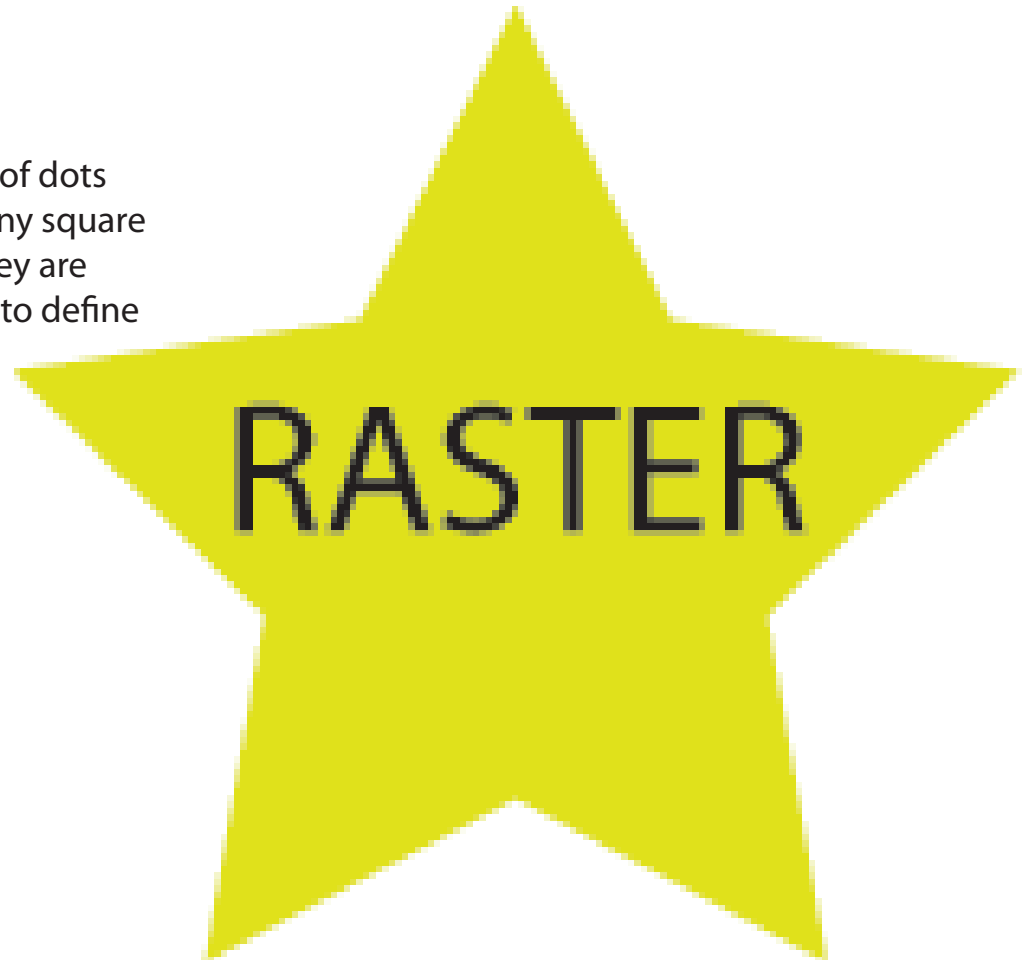
## VECTOR
